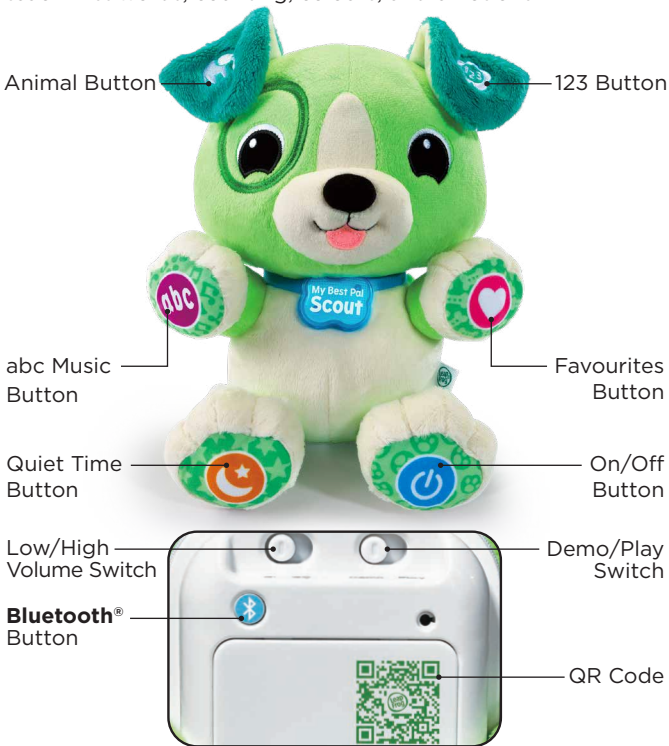

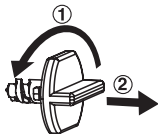

WARNING

Keep this soft toy out of the sleeping environment for babies under twelve months to avoid suffocation risk.

Unlock the Packaging Locks:

- ① Turn the packaging lock anticlockwise several times.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging lock.



WARNING

Adult assembly needed. Close the battery door and tighten the screw to secure before giving your child the toy.

GETTING STARTED

PERSONALISATION

Scout/Violet can learn your child's name, favourite colour, food, and animal! To get started, scan the QR code to the right (also found on the battery box) or go to **leapfrog.com/mybestpal** to download the LeapFrog Link app on your smartphone or tablet (see system requirements below). Follow the instructions in the app to choose your child's name, favourite food, animal, and colour!

ACTIVATE NORMAL PLAY MODE

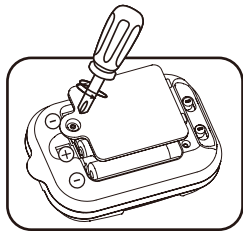
This product is set to **Demo Mode** in the package. Slide the **Demo/Play** switch to **Play** to access all the features, including up to 15 minutes of Quiet Time music.



BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.

3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 3 new 1.5V AA (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

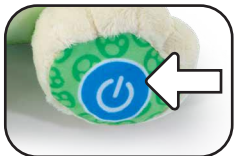

PRODUCT FEATURES

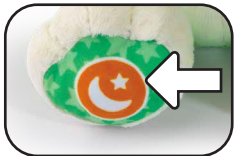
1. On/Off Button

Press the **On/Off Button** to wake up Scout/Violet and begin play.



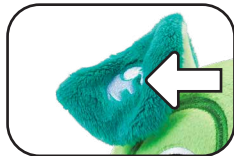
2. Quiet Time Button

Press the **Quiet Time Button** to select 5, 10 or 15 minutes of calming music. You can press the button again to select another time setting before the music starts. Once the music starts, press this button to change to the next calming music track.



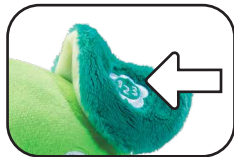
3. Animal Button

Press the **Animal Button** to hear fun animal sounds and guess what animal Scout/Violet is pretending to be.



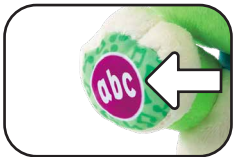
4. 123 Button

Press the **123 Button** to learn about counting and explore calming exercises.



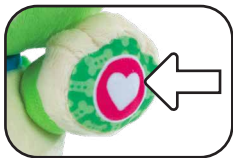
5. abc Music Button

Press the **abc Music Button** to hear music and songs including the abc song and songs that include your child's name and favourite things.



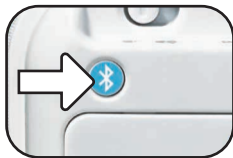
6. Favourites Button

Press the **Favourites Button** to hear songs and phrases about Scout's/ Violet's favourite things. Personalise this toy to hear Scout/Violet talk about your child's favourite things.



7. Bluetooth® Button

Make sure the toy is powered on and in **Play Mode**. After selecting your child's name and favourite things in the LeapFrog Link app, press this button to activate **Bluetooth®** and transfer the data.



8. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the toy will automatically shut off after a short time without input. In **Demo Mode** press the **On/Off Button** to wake it up. In **Play Mode**, press any button to keep playing.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
5. The unit is surface washable only.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn toy **Off** by pressing the **on/off button** on the paw.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.

Environmental phenomena

The unit may malfunction if subjected to radio-frequency interference. It should revert to normal operation when the interference stops. If not, it may become necessary to turn the power Off and back On, or remove and reinstall the batteries. In the unlikely event of an electrostatic discharge, the unit may malfunction and lose memory, requiring the user to reset the device by removing and reinstalling the batteries.
