

# Animal Habitats Around the World

Animals live all around the world, in different habitats. A habitat is a place where a particular animal can find food, shelter, protection and a community of other animals. Animals often have traits that help it survive in a habitat, like thick fur in cold habitat, or a skin color that helps it blend in with its surroundings. Each of these animals lives in a habitat located in one of the biomes shown here. Draw a line to connect the animals to their biomes. What do you notice about each animal? How does each animal's appearance help you to decide where it lives?
