# **Important Safety Instructions**

The applied name plate is located at the bottom of the Baby Unit's base. When using your equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury, including the following:

- 1. Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the product.
- 2. Adult setup is required.
- CAUTION: Do not install the Baby Unit at a height above 2 metres.
- This product is intended as an aid. It is not a substitute for responsible and proper adult supervision and should not be used as such.
- 5. This product is not intended for use as a medical monitor.
- Do not use this product near water, for example, near to a bath, sink, swimming pool or shower.
- 7. CAUTION: Use only the internally, non-user replaceable battery fitted to the Parent Viewer. There may be a risk of explosion if a wrong type of battery is used for the Parent Viewer. The battery cannot be subjected to high or low extreme temperature and low air pressure at high altitude during use, storage or transportation. Disposal of battery in fire or a hot oven, mechanically crushing or cutting or the battery can result in an explosion. Leaving the battery in an extremely high temperature surrounding environment can result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid of gas. Battery subjected to extremely low air pressure may result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid or gas. Dispose of used batteries according to the instructions.
- 8. Use only the adaptors included with this product. Incorrect adaptor polarity or voltage can seriously damage the product. Use only the adaptors and battery listed below.

- The power adaptors are intended to be correctly oriented in a vertical or floor mount position. The prongs are not designed to hold the plug in place if it is plugged into a ceiling, underthe-table or cabinet outlet.
- 10. For pluggable equipment, the socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.
- 11. Unplug this product from the wall outlet before cleaning.
- Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. Use a damp cloth for cleaning. Do not modify the power adaptors or replace with other adaptors.
- 13. Do not allow anything to rest on the power cords. Do not install this product where the cords may be walked on or crimped.
- 14. This product should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the marking label. If you are not sure of the type of power supply in your home, consult your dealer or electricity supply provider.
- 15. Do not overload wall outlets or use an extension cord.
- 16. Do not place this product on an unstable table, shelf, stand or other unstable surfaces.

- 24. The small parts of this monitor can be swallowed by babies or small children. Keep these parts out of reach of children.
- 25. The product is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

- Use and store the product at a temperature between 0°C and 40°C.




# **Connect and Charge the Baby Monitor**

# 1. Connect the Baby Monitor

#### Note:

• Baby Unit turns on automatically after it connects to the power socket.



### 2. Charge the Parent Viewer Battery

#### **Notes:**


- Before using the baby monitor for the first time, charge the Parent Viewer battery for 12 hours. When the Parent Viewer battery is fully charged, the battery icon segments are solid .....
- The standby time varies depending on your actual usage time and the age of the battery.

The battery icon on the screen indicates the battery status:

Battery Indicators	Battery Status	Action
The screen displays	The battery is low in power and may only be used for a short time.	Charge without interruption (about 30 minutes).
The battery icon segments are solid (IIII).	The battery is fully charged.	To keep the battery charged, connect it to AC power when in use.

# 3. Power On or Off the Baby Monitor

- Connect the power adaptor to the Baby Unit and a power supply to power on the unit.
- Disconnect from the power supply to power off.



Press and hold Until the welcome screen appears. The LINK LED light flashes green.



#### 4. Status Check


Once your Baby Unit and Parent Viewer are powered on and connected, your Parent Viewer displays video from Baby Unit, and the CD LINK LED lights steadily.

# 5. Positioning the Baby Monitor



#### Caution:

Keep the baby unit out of the reach of your baby. Never place or mount the baby unit inside the baby's cot or playpen.




#### Note:

To avoid interference from other electronic devices, place your baby monitor at least 1 metre away from devices such as wireless routers, microwaves, mobile phones and computers.


The default volume of your Parent Viewer is level 3, and the maximum volume is level 5. If you experience feedback noise from your baby monitor while positioning:


- Make sure your Baby Unit and Parent Viewer are more than 1 metre apart, **OR**
- Lower the volume of your Parent Viewer.


