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Important Safety Instructions

The applied nameplate is located at the bottom of the Baby Unit's base.

When using your equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury, including the following:

1. Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the product.
2. Adult setup is required.
3. **CAUTION:** Do not install the Baby Unit at a height above 2 metres.
4. This product is intended as an aid. It is not a substitute for responsible and proper adult supervision and should not be used as such.
5. This product is not intended for use as a medical monitor.
6. Do not use this product near water, for example, near to a bath, sink, swimming pool or shower.
7. **CAUTION:** Use only the internal, non-user replaceable battery fitted to the Parent unit. There may be a risk of explosion if a wrong type of battery is used for the Parent unit. The battery cannot be subjected to high or low extreme temperature and low air pressure at high altitude during use, storage or transportation. Disposal of batteries in fire or a hot oven, mechanically crushing or cutting the battery can result in an explosion. Subjecting products or batteries to an extremely high temperature environment can result in explosion or leakage of flammable liquids, or gas. Products or batteries subjected to extremely low air pressures may result in explosion or leakage of flammable liquids, or gas.
8. Use only the power adaptors included with this product. Incorrect power adaptor polarity or voltage can seriously damage the product.

9. The power adaptors are intended to be correctly oriented in a vertical or floor mount position. The prongs are not designed to hold the plug in place if it is plugged into a ceiling, under-the-table or cabinet outlet.
10. For pluggable equipment, the socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.

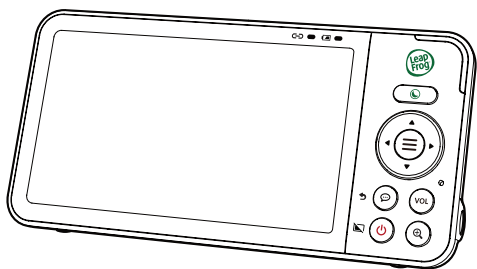

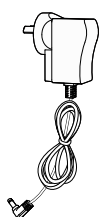
1. Use and store the product at a temperature between 0°C and 40°C.
2. Do not expose the product to extreme cold, heat or direct sunlight. Do not put the product close to a heating source.
3. Batteries should not be exposed to excessive heat such as bright sunshine or fire.
4. Mishandling batteries can cause burn, fire or explosion hazards.
5.  **Warning**—Strangulation Hazard—Children have STRANGLED in cords. Keep this cord out of the reach of children (more than 0.9m away). Do not remove warning label on the adaptor cord.

1	 LINK LED Indicator - On when the Parent unit is linked to the Baby Unit. - Flashes when the link to the Baby Unit is lost.
2	 Battery LED Indicator - On when the Parent unit is connected to AC power, and the battery is charging. - Flashes when the Parent unit battery is low and needs to be charged.
3	3-level sound indicator light
4	 Night Mode quick set key - Select  black-and-white night vision for extreme darkness or  colour night vision for dim environments (the use of the Baby Unit night light or other supplementary light sources is required). - To activate night light in colour night vision, press  to turn it on for 30 seconds, and press  or  to adjust its brightness.
5	 Menu / Select - Press to enter the main menu. - While in a menu, press to confirm a selection, or save a setting.

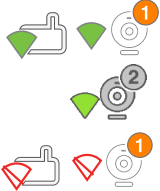

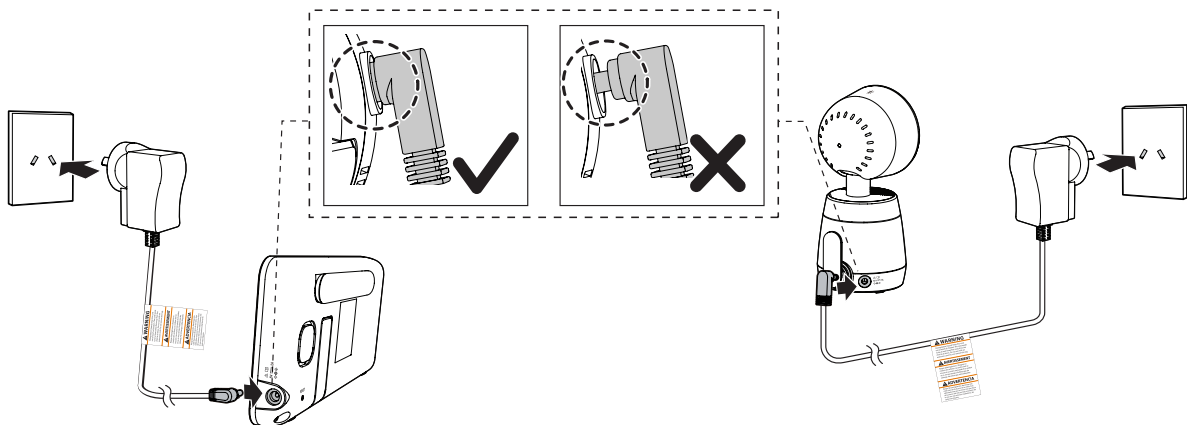
Connect, Charge, and Power On the Baby Monitor

1. Connect the Baby Monitor

Connect the Parent unit and Baby Unit to a power supply with the included power adaptors.

Notes:

- The rechargeable battery in the Parent unit is built-in.
- Use only the power adaptors supplied with this product.
- Connect the power adaptors in a vertical or floor mount position only. The adaptor prongs are not designed to hold the weight of the Parent unit and the Baby Unit, so do not connect them to any ceiling, under-the-table, or cabinet outlets. Otherwise, the adaptors may not properly connect to the outlets.
- Make sure the Parent unit, the Baby Unit and the power adaptor cords are out of reach of children.



2. Charge the Parent unit Battery

The Parent unit runs on a rechargeable battery or AC power. To continuously monitor your baby, keep the Parent unit connected to AC power.

The Parent unit turns on automatically after it connects to the power socket, and its battery will charge at the same time.

Notes:

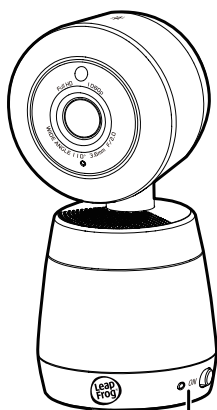
- Before using the baby monitor for the first time, charge the Parent unit battery for 12 hours. When the Parent unit battery is fully charged, the battery icon becomes solid .
- The standby time varies depending on your actual use.

The battery icon on the screen indicates the battery status (see the following table).

Battery Indicators	Battery Status	Action
 and  are displayed on the Parent unit screen; the red  LED flashing.	The battery has very little charge and may only be used for a short time.	Charge without interruption (about 30 minutes).
The battery icon segments are solid  .	The battery is fully charged.	To keep the battery charged, connect it to AC power when in use.

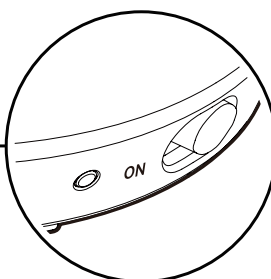
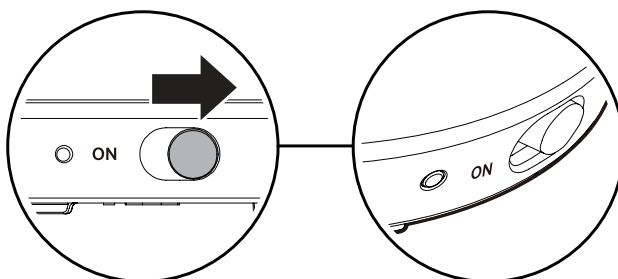
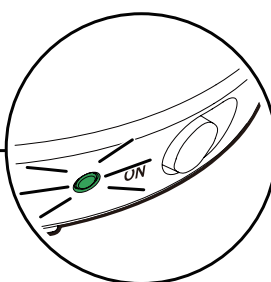
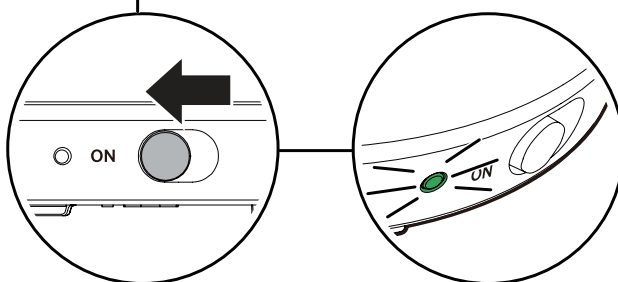
3. Power On or Off the Baby Monitor

1. Slide the On/Off switch to **ON** to power on your Baby Unit.



Note:

- The status LED is set to off by default. You can turn it on using the app.



2. The Parent unit turns on automatically after connecting to the power socket, and the welcome screen appears. Then, the green  LINK LED light flashes and turns on steady when connected.

You can press and hold  to turn it on or off.



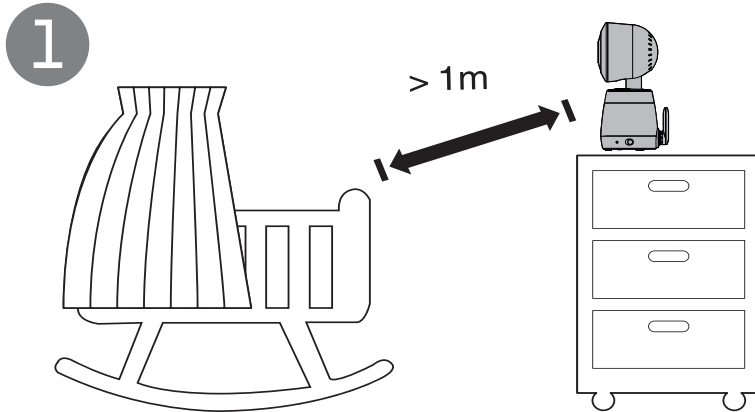
4. Status Check

Once your Baby Unit and Parent unit are successfully connected, your Parent unit displays video from the Baby Unit, and the green  LINK LED remains on.

5. Positioning the Baby Monitor

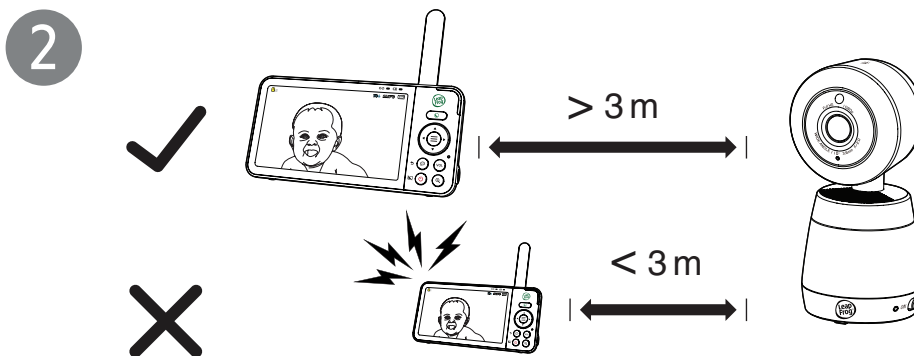
Caution: Keep the Baby Unit out of the reach of your baby. Never place or mount the Baby Unit inside the baby's cot or playpen.

Place the Baby Unit more than 1m away from your baby.

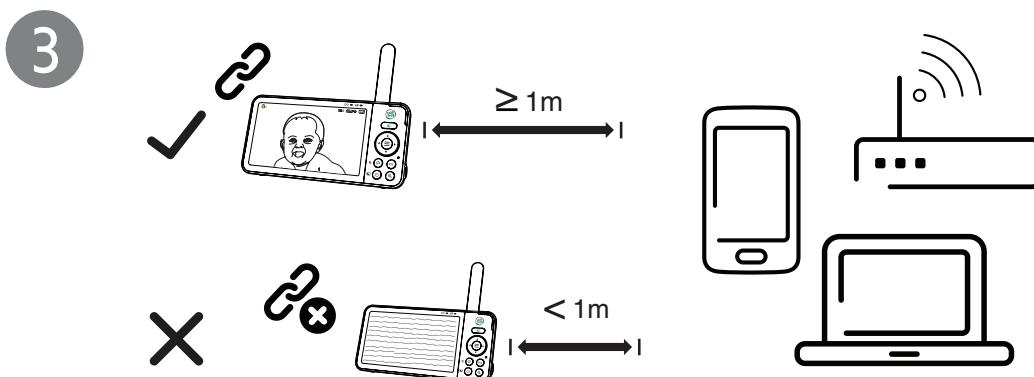


Cautions:

- The default volume of your Parent unit is level 3, and the maximum volume is level 5. If you experience feedback noise from your baby monitor while positioning:
 - Make sure your Baby Unit and Parent unit are more than 3 metres apart; **OR**
 - Lower the volume of your Parent unit.



- To avoid interference from other electronic devices, place your baby monitor at least 1 metre away from devices such as wireless routers, microwave ovens, mobile phones and computers.

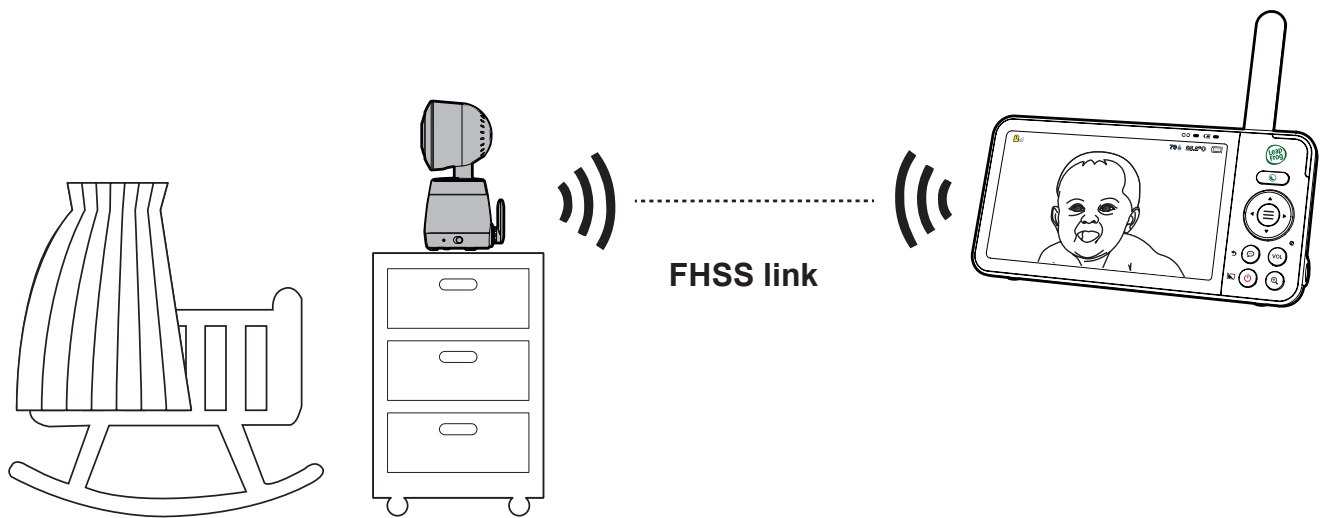


Two Ways to Connect Your Baby Monitor

TIP: To receive product firmware updates, this baby monitor requires connecting to a 2.4GHz home Wi-Fi network..

Direct Connect Mode

Your baby monitor Parent Unit and Baby Unit connect to each other in **Direct Connect Mode** by default, which allows you to immediately stream video out of the box.

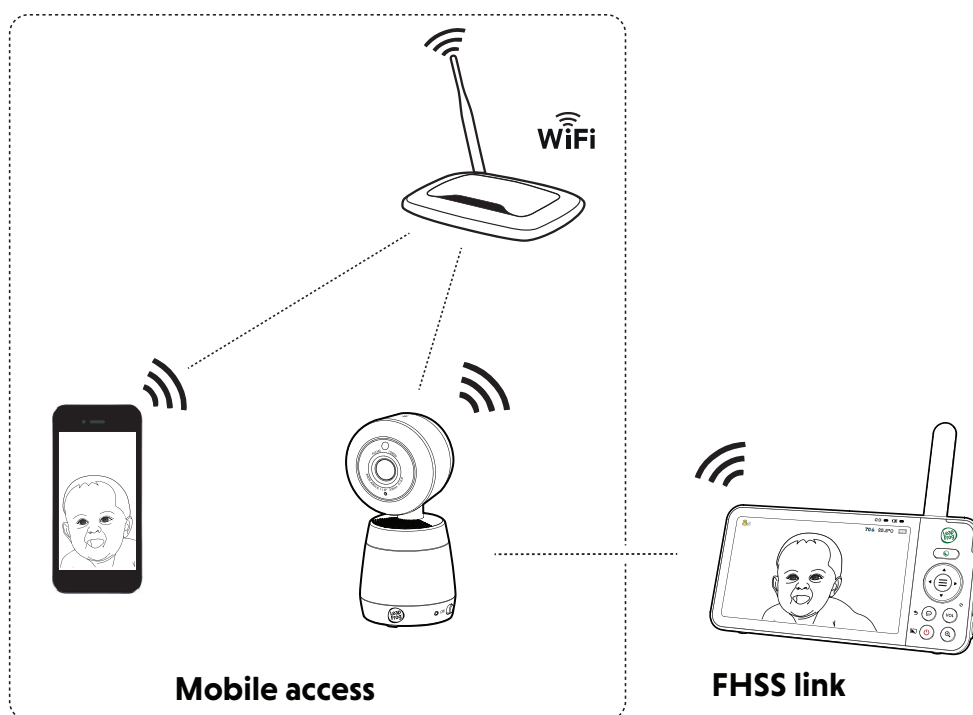


App Connect Mode

To enhance your experience and enjoy seamless live video streaming via your mobile app, and to receive product software updates (when available), we highly recommend setting up your monitor's Wi-Fi connection.

It uses your 2.4GHz home Wi-Fi network to connect your video monitor and supports live video streaming through the mobile app.

To stream live video remotely with your mobile device, download and install the **LeapFrog Baby Care+** mobile app. With the mobile app, your Wi-Fi router (not included) provides Internet connectivity to your HD video monitor system. It serves as a communication channel between your Baby Unit and mobile device, allowing you to monitor and/or control your Baby Unit wherever you are.



Wi-Fi and Mobile App Set-up

Use the **Leapfrog Baby Care +** on your mobile device to monitor your baby remotely. Follow the instructions below to set up and pair your baby monitor with the app.



1. Scan the QR code to download the free **Leapfrog Baby Care +** mobile app, or search “Leapfrog Baby Care +” on App Store or Google Play Store. If you have previously installed the app, ensure that you have the latest version.

NOTE

- Make sure your mobile device meets the minimum requirement for the mobile app.

Minimum requirement

The mobile app is compatible with:

- Android™ 9.0 or later; and
- iOS 15 or later.



2. Tap  to launch the mobile app on your device and create an account.
3. We recommend that you use common webmail services, such as Google Gmail, to register your user account. Check your email (including the Spam folder) and activate your new account by entering the email verification code. Then, sign in to your account.
4. Ensure that you are connected to a **2.4GHz Wi-Fi network** and have enabled **Bluetooth** and **Location Service** on your device.
5. After signing in to the app, select **Camera(s) with Parent unit** and scan the QR code displayed on the parent unit. To find the QR code, press  button and go to  >  **Connect to Mobile App**.
6. Input the Wi-Fi password.
7. Press and hold the pair key on the baby unit for 3 seconds until you hear the beep sound to enter pairing mode.
8. Select the camera model that appears in the app and wait for the camera to connect. Once connected, it will display a live view preview.
9. Select “**Continue**” and create a profile for your baby (Optional). Now you can start monitoring! (For models with 2 cameras, a pop-up will ask if you wish connect another camera. Repeat steps 7-9 for the second camera.)

Tips:

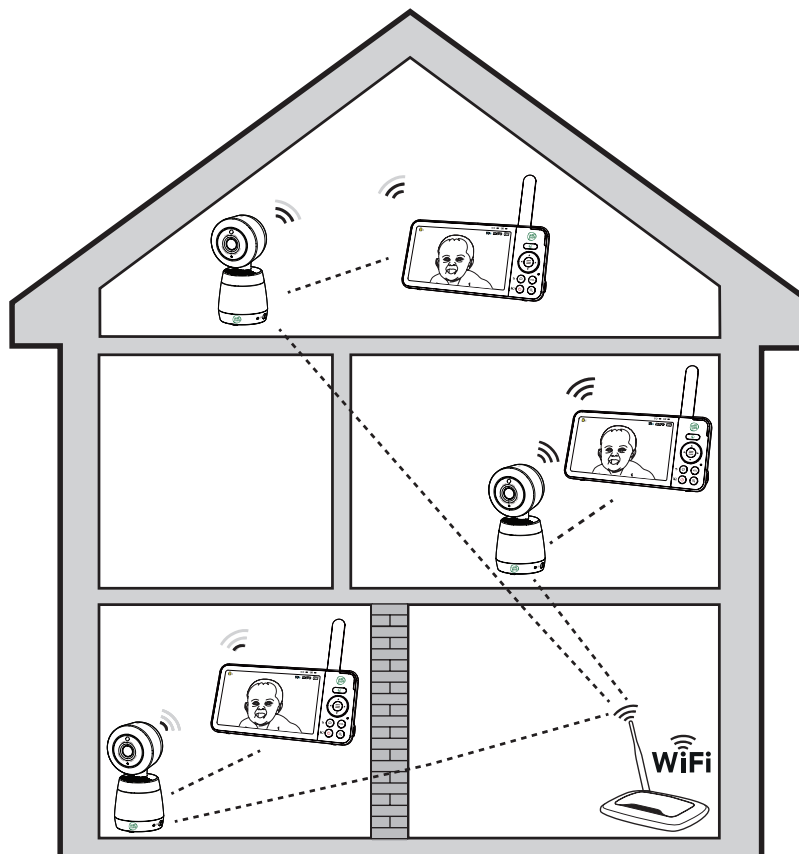
Use **Camera Sharing** to instantly share access to the camera. Follow these steps:

1. Go to **Menu** and select **Camera Sharing**.
2. Choose “**Invite People**” and enter the name and email address of the family member’s app account.
3. The family member will receive a pop-up notification in the app and can accept the invitation to access the camera(s).

Test the Best Location for the Baby Unit

If you plan to install your baby unit in a designated location, and use your home Wi-Fi network to connect your video monitor, you need to test which of your selected monitoring areas within the house have good Wi-Fi signal strength. After you have powered on your parent unit, you can use your parent unit’s **App Connect Mode signal icon(s)** to assist in checking. Once you have identified the suitable location, you can install your baby unit. Adjust the distance between your baby unit and the Wi-Fi router if needed.

Note: Surroundings and obstructing factors, such as large metallic objects, filing cabinets, long distances, electrical appliances, and internal walls, may reduce Wi-Fi signal.



Protect Your Privacy and Online Security

LeapFrog cares about your privacy and peace of mind. That's why we've put together a list of industry-recommended best practices to help keep your wireless connection private and your devices protected when online.

Ensure your wireless connection is secure

- Before installing a device, ensure your router's wireless signal is encrypted by selecting the "WPA2-PSK with AES" setting in your router's wireless security menu.

Change default settings

- Change your wireless router's default wireless network name (SSID) to something unique.
- Change default passwords to unique, strong passwords. A strong password:
 - Is at least 10 characters long.

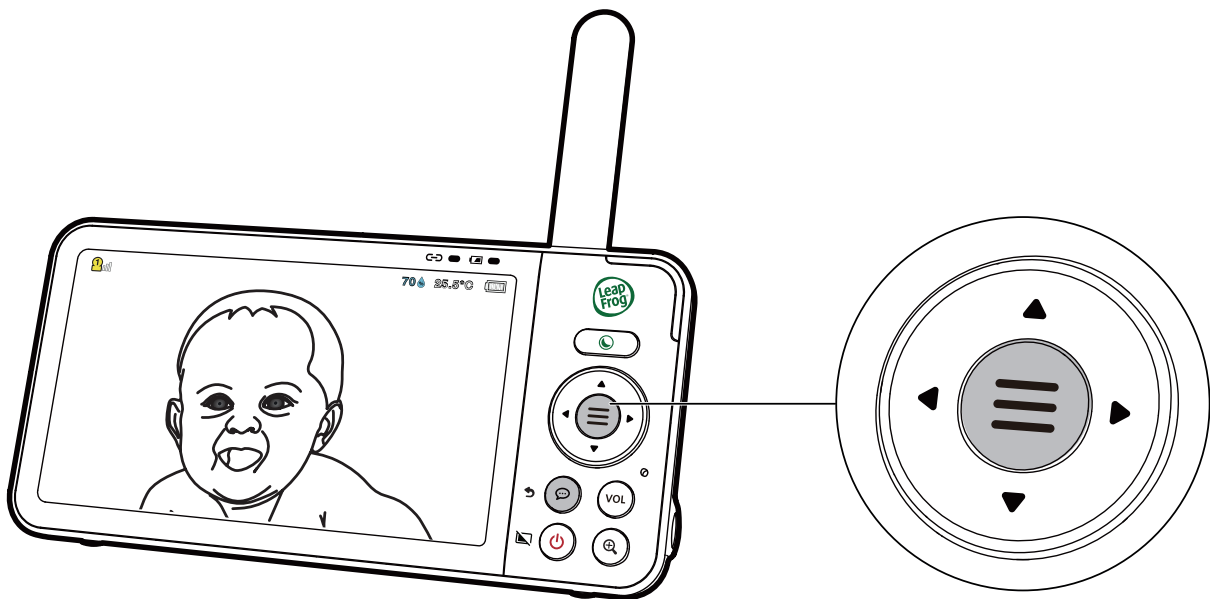
Basic Operation

Use the Menu

Press  on the Parent unit to enter the main menu, choose a menu item, or save a setting. You can use the parent unit menu for advanced settings or operations, such as to play or stop the Baby Unit lullaby, or adjust the Baby Unit motion sensitivity.

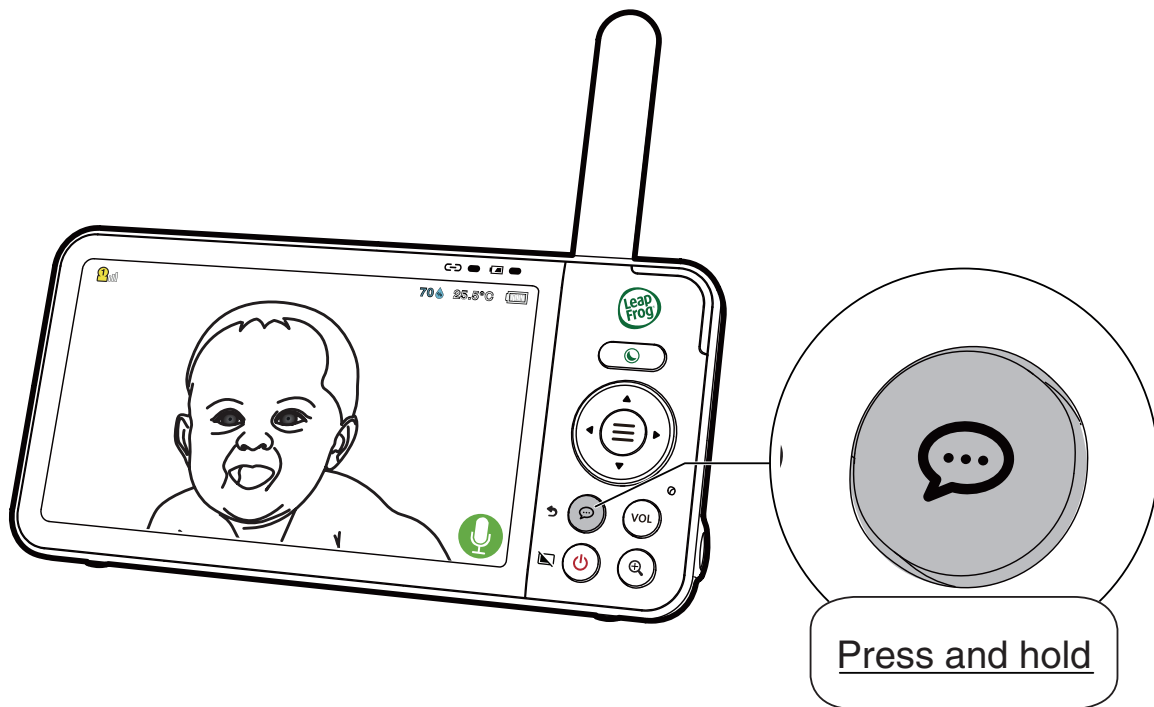
While in the menu:

- Press the Arrow Keys     to scroll among the menu options.
- Press  to select an item.
- Press  to return to the previous menu.



Talk to Your Baby via the Baby Unit

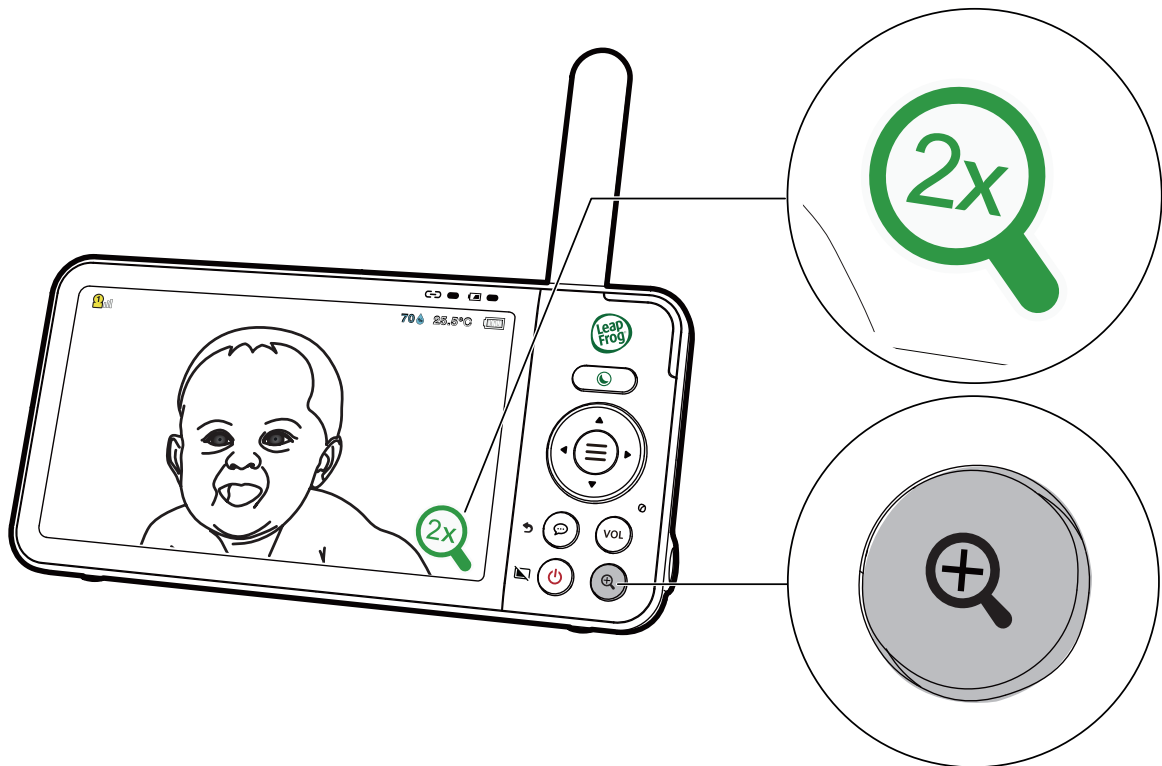
1. Press and hold  key on the Parent unit.
2. When the icon  displays on the screen, speak to your Parent unit. Your voice is transmitted to the Baby Unit.
3. When finished talking, release  to hear your baby again.



Zoom, Pan and Tilt the Camera

Zoom

- Press  to zoom in or out. The zoom sequence is , , .

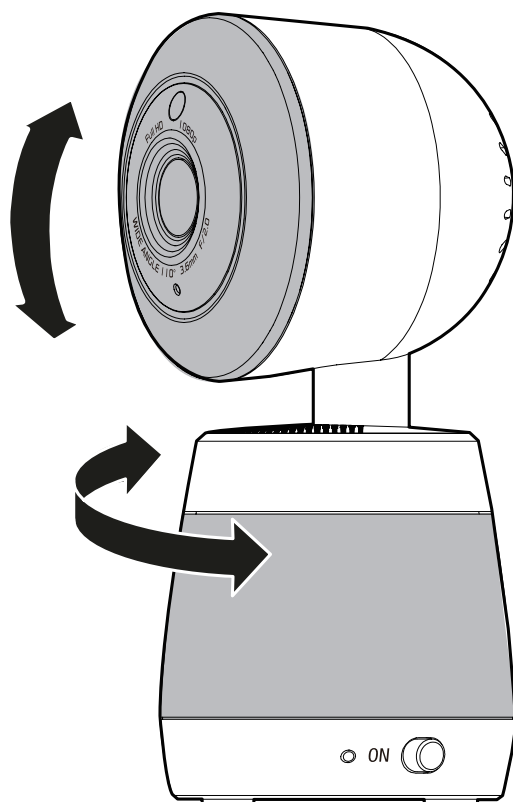


Pan and Tilt the Camera

You can use the arrow keys on the Parent unit to pan and tilt the camera.

- Press the arrow keys ▲ ▼ ◀ ▶ to move the camera upward, downward, leftward and rightward, or press and hold ▲ ▼ ◀ ▶ to move continuously.

OR Manually tilt the camera angle up and down by pushing the lens portion upwards or downwards to aim at your baby.



Adjust Parent unit Speaker Volume

Press **VOL** button to view the volume adjustment bar.

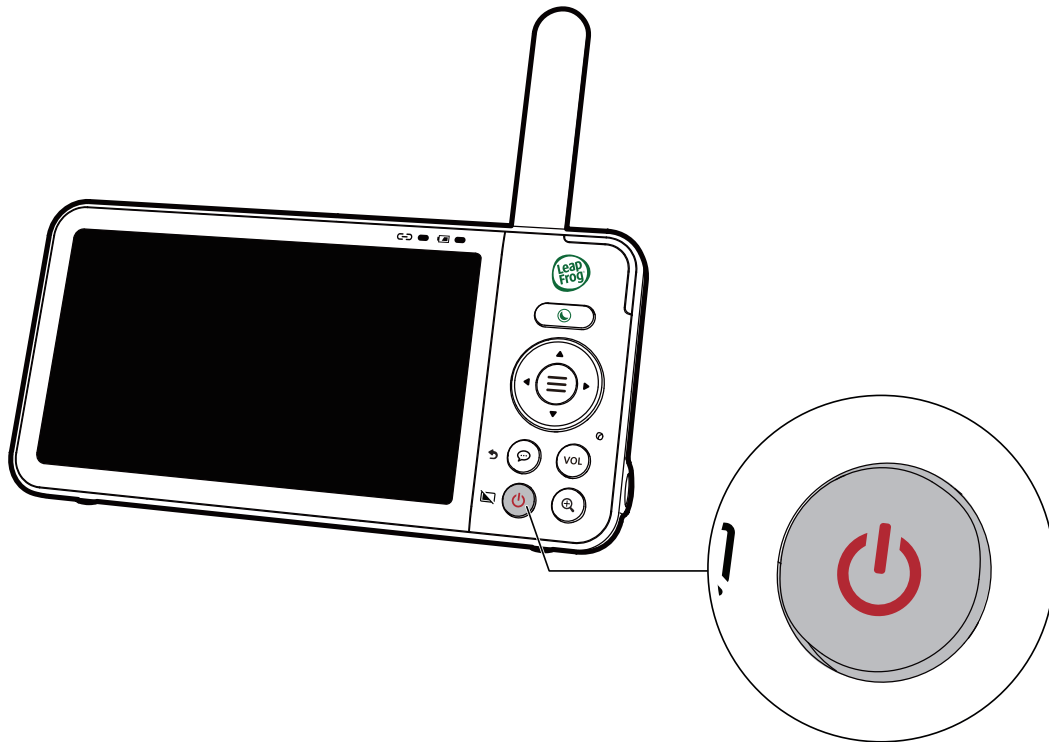
Press ▲ or ▼ to adjust the Parent unit speaker volume level

◀ [Volume Bar] ▶ (Level 1 - Lowest to Level 5 - Highest),
received from the Baby Unit.

Turn on/off the Parent unit Screen

You can turn on or turn off the Parent unit screen without powering off the Parent unit. You will still be able to hear sounds from the Baby Unit.

- Press  on the Parent unit to turn off the screen.
- Press **any key** on the Parent unit to turn on the screen again.



Adjust Parent unit Screen Brightness

1. Press  to enter the main menu.
2. Press ◀ or ▶ to select  **General Settings**, press .
3. Press ◀ or ▶ to select  **Screen Brightness**.
4. Press ◀ or ▶ to adjust the LCD brightness 
(Level 1 - Lowest to Level 5 - Highest)

Adjust Baby Unit Speaker Volume

1. Press **MENU/SELECT**  to enter the main menu.
2. Press ◀ or ▶ to select , press .
3. Press ▼ to scroll **Camera Volume** .
4. Press ◀ or ▶ to adjust the Baby Unit speaker volume 
(Level 1 - Lowest to Level 5 - Highest).

Advanced Operation

Monitoring Modes (LF3925HD-2 only)

When more than one baby unit is paired to the parent unit, you can choose to view different baby units in three monitoring modes. Learn more about each below:

Single Mode		The screen displays images only from the selected baby unit in full screen.
Split Mode		The screen displays images from all paired baby units at the same time in split view.
Patrol Mode		The screen displays a single cam view that transitions to a different baby unit every 10 seconds.

Change the Monitoring Mode

1. Press  when the parent unit is idle.
2. Press  or  to enter  **Monitoring Mode** menu.
3. Press  or  to choose between **Single**  , **Split**  , and **Patrol**  monitoring mode options. Press  to confirm.

Night Vision

The Baby Unit has infrared LEDs that allow you to see your baby clearly at night or in a dark room. When the Baby Unit being viewed detects low light levels, the infrared LEDs switch on automatically. When **Black-and-White Night Vision** mode is activated,  appears on the screen. When **Colour Night Vision** mode is activated,  appears on the screen.

Night Vision Mode	Description
	B&W Night Vision • Suitable for extremely dark or low light environments. • Images will be in black-and-white.
	Colour Night Vision • Suitable for dim environments. • This feature must be used with a supplementary light source. • You can turn the baby unit night light on or use other light sources. • Images will be in colour.

Change your viewing mode

1. Press the Night Mode quick set key  to turn on night mode,  displays.
2. Press ◀ or ▶ to select  or  to select black-and-white or colour night mode.

Turn on night light in colour night vision mode

3. Press ▲ to turn on the white night light for 30s  (when selected colour night mode).
4. Press ▲ or ▼ to adjust the night light brightness .

Notes:

- With insufficient supplementary lighting, the colour night vision image will appear dark.
- It is **normal** to see a short white glare on your Parent unit screen as the Baby Unit adapts to the dark environment.
- If you adjust the night vision mode while night vision is not activated, the new settings will be saved and applied the **next time** activates.

Tip:

- The video quality may vary depending on the surrounding environment and interfering factors like lighting, objects, colour and backgrounds. Adjust the Baby Unit angle or place the Baby Unit at a higher elevation to prevent glare and a blurry display.

Night Light

On the Baby Unit

Turn on or turn off the night light

- Press the **Night light touch control**  located on the top of the Baby Unit to turn on or turn off the night light.

Adjust the brightness

- Press and hold the **Night light touch control**  to adjust the night light brightness.

On the Parent unit

Turn on the night light

1. Press  to enter the main menu.
2. Press  again to enter  **Night Light Menu**.
3. Press  or  to select **On** , press .

Turn off the night light

1. Press  to enter the main menu.
2. Press  again to enter  **Night Light Menu**.
3. Press  or  to select **Off** , press **MENU/SELECT** .

Adjust the night light colour

1. Press  to enter the main menu.
2. Press  again to enter .
3. Press  or  to select  **Colour**, press .
4. Choose your desired colour.
5. (**Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Pink, White, Blue, Rainbow, Warm color or Cool color**), then press .

Tip:

- **Customized color** is available if your Baby Unit is paired with **LeapFrog Baby Care+** App.

Adjust the night light brightness

1. Press  to enter the main menu.
Press  again to enter .
2. Press  or  to select  **Brightness**, press .
3. Choose your desired brightness level       (**Auto - Set the brightness to Auto adaptive ambience, Level 1 - dimmest, Level 2, Level 3, Level 4, Level 5 - brightest**), then press .

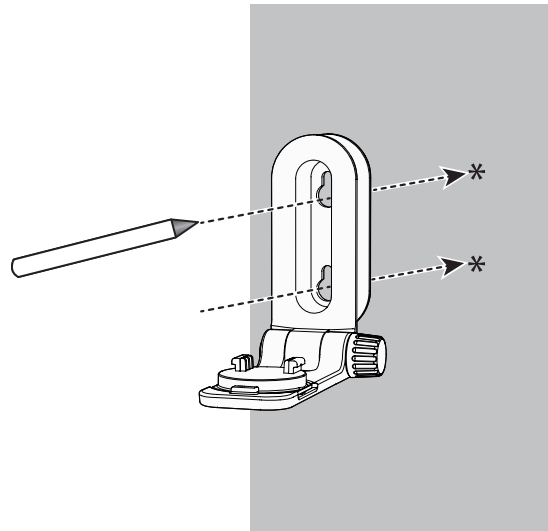

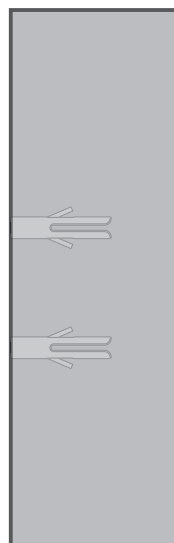

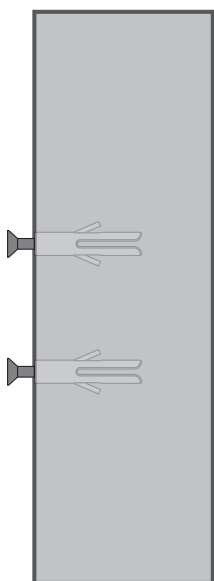
1. Place the wall mount bracket on a wall and then use a pencil to mark the top and the bottom holes as shown. Remove the wall mount bracket and drill two holes in the wall 5.5 mm drill bit.



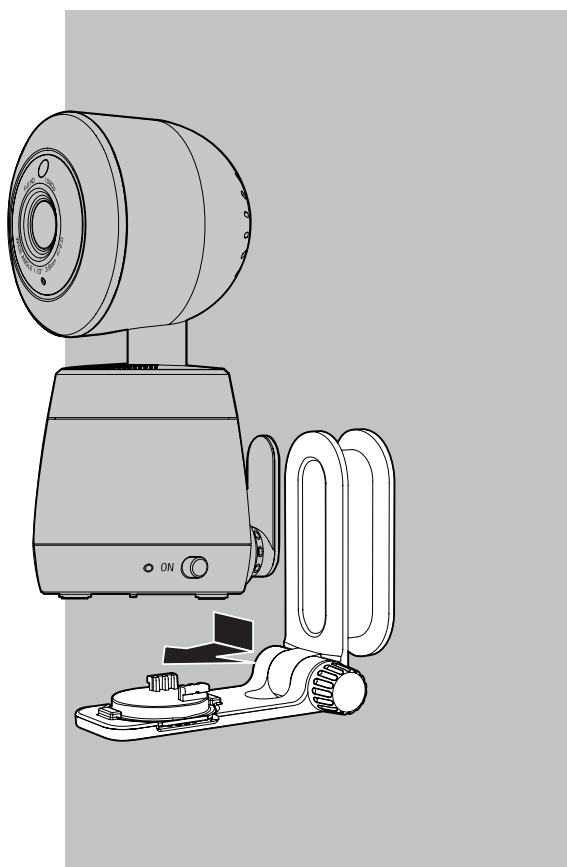
2. If you drill the holes into a stud, go to step 3.
 - If you drill the holes into an object other than a stud, insert the wall plugs into the holes. Tap gently on the ends with a hammer until the wall plugs are flush with the wall.



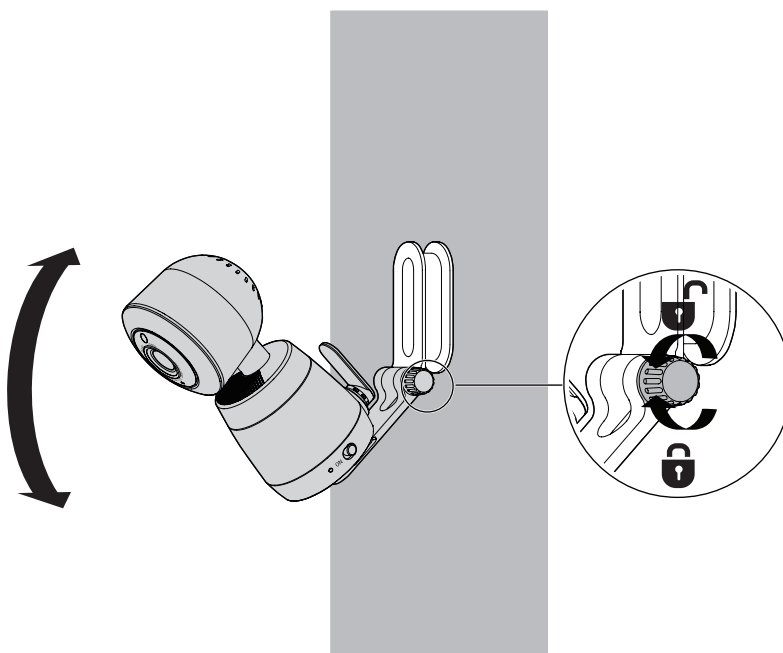
3. Insert the screws into the holes and tighten the screws until only 6.5 mm of the screws are exposed.



4. Place the Baby Unit on the wall mount bracket. Tighten the screw into the threaded socket at the bottom to secure the Baby Unit. Align the holes on the wall mount bracket with the screws on the wall, and slide the wall mount bracket down until it locks into place.



5. You can maximize your Baby Unit's viewing angles by tilting the wall mount bracket. Hold the Baby Unit, and then rotate the knob in an anti-clockwise direction. This will loosen the joint of the wall mount bracket. Tilt your Baby Unit up or down to adjust to your preferred angle. Then, rotate the knob in a clockwise direction to tighten the joint and secure the angle.
