
### Caution:

The default volume of your Parent Viewer is level 3, and the maximum volume is level 5. If you experience any eedback noise from your baby monitor while positioning

- Make sure your Baby Unit and Parent Viewer are more than 3 metres apart, **OR**
- Lower the volume of your Parent Viewer.

To avoid interference from other electronic devices, place your baby monitor at least 1 metre away from devices such as wireless routers, microwave ovens, mobile phones and computers.

It uses your 2.4GHz home Wi-Fi network to connect your video monitor and supports live video streaming through the mobile app.


