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Important Safety Instructions

The applied name plate is located at the bottom of the Baby Unit's base. When using your equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury, including the following:

- 1. Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the product.
- 2. Adult setup is required.
- CAUTION: Do not install the Baby Unit at a height above 2 metres.
- This product is intended as an aid. It is not a substitute for responsible and proper adult supervision and should not be used as such.
- 5. This product is not intended for use as a medical monitor.
- 6. Do not use this product near water, for example, near to a bath, sink, swimming pool or shower.
- 7. CAÚTION: Use only the battery provided. There may be a risk of explosion if a wrong type of battery is used for the Parent Unit. The battery cannot be subjected to high or low extreme temperature and low air pressure at high altitude during use, storage or transportation. Disposal of battery in fire or a hot oven, mechanically crushing or cutting or the battery can result in an explosion. Leaving the battery in an extremely high temperature surrounding environment can result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid of gas. Battery subjected to extremely low air pressure may result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid or gas. Dispose of used batteries according to the instructions.
- 8. Use only the adaptors included with this product. Incorrect adaptor polarity or voltage can seriously damage the product.
- 9. Use only the adaptors and battery listed below.


- 10. The power adaptors are intended to be correctly oriented in a vertical or floor mount position. The prongs are not designed to hold the plug in place if it is plugged into a ceiling, under-thetable or cabinet outlet.
- 11. For pluggable equipment, the socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.
- 12. Unplug this product from the wall outlet before cleaning.
- 13. Unplug the power cords before replacing batteries.
- Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. Use a damp cloth for cleaning. Do not modify the power adapters or replace with other adaptors.
- 15. Do not allow anything to rest on the power cords. Do not install this product where the cords may be walked on or crimped.
- 16. This product should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the marking label. If you are not sure of the type of power supply in your home, consult your dealer or electricity supply provider.
- 17. Do not overload wall outlets or use an extension cord.
- Do not place this product on an unstable table, shelf, stand or other unstable surfaces.

- 19. This product should not be placed in any area where proper ventilation is not provided. Slots and openings in the back or bottom of this product are provided for ventilation. To protect them from overheating, these openings must not be blocked by placing the product on a soft surface such as a bed, sofa or rug. This product should never be placed near or over a radiator or heat source.
- Never push objects of any kind into this product through the slots because they may touch dangerous voltage points or create a short circuit. Never spill liquid of any kind on the product.

- 26. The small parts of this monitor can be swallowed by babies or small children. Keep these parts out of reach of children.
- 27. The product is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.


- 1. Use and store the product at a temperature between 0°C and $40^{\circ}\text{C}.$
- 2. Mishandling batteries can cause burn, fire or explosion hazards.
- 3. Do not expose the product to extreme cold, heat or direct sunlight. Do not place the product close to a heating source.
- 4. Batteries should not be exposed to excessive heat such as bright sunshine or fire.






- Never place the Baby Unit(s) inside the baby's cot or playpen.

Try installing your baby monitor as far away from these electronic devices as possible: wireless routers, radios, cellular telephones, intercoms, room monitors, televisions, personal computers, kitchen appliances and cordless telephones.

Connect and Charge the Baby Monitor


1. Install Parent Unit Batteries





Notes:

- Only use and replace batteries with models listed in Important Safety Instructions (9).
- If the Baby Monitor is not intended to be used for long periods, disconnect and remove the batteries to prevent possible leakage.

2. Install Baby Unit Batteries








3. Connect the Baby Monitor

Notes:

- Use only the power adaptors supplied with this product.
- If your Baby Monitor is connected to a timer controlled socket, make sure it is switched on.
- Connect the power adaptors in a vertical or floor mount position only.
- Make sure Parent Unit, Baby Unit and the power adaptor cords are out of reach of children.



4. Charge the Baby Monitor

When you have connected and turned on the Parent Unit and Baby Unit, the batteries will charge automatically.

The battery icon on the screen indicates the battery status:

Battery Indicators	Battery Status	Action
The unit beeps and the screen displays .	The battery is low in power and may only be used for a short time.	Charge without interruption (about 30 minutes).
The battery icon becomes solid .	The battery is fully charged.	To keep the battery charged, connect it to AC power when in use.

Notes:


- Before using the Baby Monitor for the first time, charge the Parent Unit and Baby Unit batteries for 12 hours.
- The standby time varies depending on the sensitivity level you set, your actual usage, and the age of the batteries.

5. Power On or Off the Baby Monitor

1. Press and hold **(b)** to power on or power off Baby Unit.





2. Press and hold **t** to power on or power off Parent Unit.



Position the Baby Monitor








(!) Caution:

- The default speaker volume of your Parent Unit is level 3. If you experience feedback from your baby monitor while positioning:
 - Make sure your Baby Unit and Parent Unit are more than 2 metres apart, OR
 - Turn down the volume of Parent Unit.




Notes:












- On when night light is turned on manually.
- Off when night light is turned off manually.

2 Changeable face plate

3 POWER light

- On when Baby Unit is powered on.
- Off when Baby Unit is turned off.

4 Battery indication light

- On when Baby Unit's batteries are charging.
- Flashes when the batteries are low and need charging.


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- Press to play the next lullaby.
- Press and hold to record your own voice for up to 20 seconds. Release when finished recording. The recorded voice will be saved as SONG 5.

6 Microphone

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 Press to increase the speaker volume (Level 1 to Level 5).



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- · Press to turn the night light on or off.
- <u>Press and hold</u> to adjust the brightness of the night light.


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- Press and hold to power on, and the power light turns on.
- Press and hold to power off, and the power light turns off.
- When Baby Unit is powered on, press to play the selected lullaby or the recorded voice. Press again to stop playing.



General Product Care
