Important Safety Instructions

The applied name plate is located at the bottom of the Baby Unit's base. When using your equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire. electric shock and injury, including the following:

The battery cannot be subjected to high or low extreme temperature and low air pressure at high altitude during use, storage or transportation. Disposal of battery in fire or a hot oven, mechanically crushing or cutting or the battery can result in an explosion. Leaving the battery in an extremely high temperature surrounding environment can result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid of gas. When you have connected and turned on the Parent Viewer and Baby Unit, the batteries will charge automatically.



- The standby time varies depending on the sensitivity level you set, your actual usage, and the age of the batteries.


