

# Point out the letters!

One of the best ways to introduce the alphabet is through visual aids, such as picture books or toys, that include letters that can be touched. It is equally important to help your child recognize individual letters

 One fun way to begin is to point out the letters on the bus that spell out your child's name. Eventually your little one will understand that those letters, put together, stand for his name. Soon, you'll see your child begin to point out all the letters he sees and recognizes!

# Open the door to independent play!

As children enter the toddler years, their play becomes more imaginative and complex. Providing opportunities for independent play allows your child to exercise key skills and behaviors such as creativity, curiosity and problem solving.

 Encourage unstructured play (pressing letters, removing characters, creating imaginary worlds), which can help your child experience and learn about the world around her, and creates a place for her imagination to blossom!

# **Music and movement!**

kindergarten. I'm learning to read, I like to spell, and I like to learn cool facts about everything. I also love to paint


and draw. I'm always looking for new friends to draw pictures with. Maybe you and I can draw together?

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLAY



#### **Getting Started:**

Turn on the LEARNING FRIENDS™ PHONICS BUS™ Play Set by sliding the mode selector to any of the three modes. The LEARNING FRIENDS™ PHONICS BUS™ Play Set will automatically turn off after 2 minutes of inactivity.

# How to Play with the LEARNING FRIENDS™ PHONICS BUS™ Play Set: Letter Names Mode AgC

- Slide the mode selector to Letter Names mode.
- Letter play: Press any letter to hear its name.
- Character play: Place one of the three characters in the front seat to hear a version of the Wheels on the Bus song.

# Letter Sounds Mode

- Slide the mode selector to Letter Sounds mode.
- Letter play: Press any letter to hear its sound.
- Character play: Place one of the three characters in the front seat to hear rhymes about the alphabet.

# Music Mode 🎝

- Slide the mode selector to Music mode.
- Letter play: Press any letter to hear a musical ditty.
- Character play: Place characters in the front seat to hear them play their instruments. Leap plays the sax, Lily plays the guitar and Tad plays the drum.

#### Music Button:

Press to hear The Alphabet Song.

#### Volume Control:

To adjust the volume, move the volume switch to the LOW or HIGH position.

#### Care and Maintenance:

- Keep product away from foods and beverages
- Clean with a slightly damp cloth
- Never submerge product in water
- Remove batteries from product for prolonged storage
- Avoid exposing product to extreme temperatures

#### **Battery Information:**

Batteries included are for in-store demonstration, and should be replaced to improve performance. Requires 3 AA (called LR6 in some countries) alkaline batteries.

#### **Battery Safety:**

Batteries are small objects. Replacement of batteries must be done by adults. Follow the polarity (+/-) diagram in the battery compartment. Promptly remove dead batteries from the toy. Dispose of used batteries properly. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.

- DO NOT incinerate used batteries.
- DO NOT dispose of batteries in fire, as batteries may explode or leak.
- DO NOT mix old and new batteries or types of batteries (i.e. alkaline/standard).
- DO NOT use rechargeable batteries.
- DO NOT recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- DO NOT short-circuit the supply terminals.

#### Battery Installation:

- Open the battery door with a screwdriver.
- Install new batteries as shown in the polarity diagram (+/-) inside the battery compartment
- Replace battery door securely.
