

Plants Alive

Violet takes care of the plants in her garden. She knows what they need to stay alive: light, water, air, and soil. Can you collect everything a plant needs to live? Play the Plants Alive card game and see. First cut out the cards and tape or glue each one to an index card.



To Play:

This is a game for 3 to 4 players. The object of the game is to hold all of the following cards at once: light, water, air, and soil. Shuffle and deal 4 cards to each player. (For 3 players, first remove one light, water, air, and soil card.) The youngest player goes first, and play moves in a clockwise direction. On your turn, you may ask any player for a specific card. Say: "My plant needs soil."

If the other player has a soil card, he or she must then give you the card in exchange for any card you wish to give. If the other player does not have the requested card, you receive nothing and do nothing until your next turn. Play continues until one player wins by holding all 4 of the needed cards at once: light, water, air, and soil.

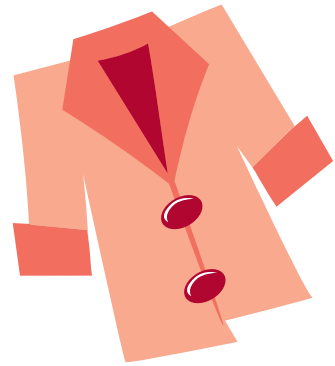

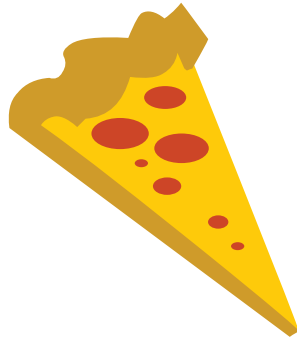

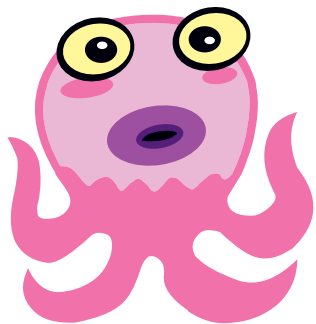
